The Devil And Miss Prym Paulo Coelho - Paulo Coelho de Souza (/ ˈ k w ɔ l . j u ː k u ː ˈ l -, -j o ː /; Portuguese: [ˈpawlu kuˈeɹu]; born 24 August 1947) is a Brazilian lyricist and novelist. He is best known for his novel *The Alchemist*. In 2014, he uploaded his personal papers online to create a virtual Paulo Coelho Foundation. The eternal conflict between good and evil is revisited in *The Devil and Miss Prym*. To tell this parable Coelho has transformed the Garden of Eden into a small village in the mountains, dozing in peaceful bliss, and the Fruit of Knowledge into gold bullion. *The Pilgrimage* (Portuguese: *O Diário de Um Mago*, "Diary of a Mage") is a 1987 novel by Brazilian novelist Paulo Coelho. It is a recollection of Paulo's experiences as he made his way across northern Spain on a pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela. The novel serves as part adventure story, part guide to self-discovery.
